

New Parent Support Program

The New Parent Support Program at MCRD San Diego offers free assistance, education, and support to military families expecting a child or raising children ages 0-5 years old. Staffed by licensed professionals, this program is designed to help parents navigate the unique challenges of military life and meet the daily demands of parenting.

#### **Home Visits**

We provide personalized support and education in the comfort of your own home. Services include:

- Newborn care and soothing techniques
- Developmental screenings and activities
- Guidance on discipline and managing challenging behaviors
- Connection to military and civilian resources
- Support for navigating military family needs such as deployments and frequent moves

#### Infant Massage

Infant massage is a gentle and meaningful way to bond, communicate and connect with your baby. We offer free individual sessions and group classes for caregivers and their babies aged four weeks to 12 months. Benefits of infant massage include improved sleep, relaxation, relief from gas, enhanced bonding and much more.

### **Cooperative Coparenting**

An eight-week course designed to help single, separated, or divorced parents build effective co-parenting skills. This course can also be offered through personalized home visits for added convenience.
