Recruiting Duty can be challenging, but navigating your child's education should not. The ERR/WRR School Liaisons can answer questions you have about K-12 education matters.

Areas the School Liaison Can Address

- Transition Services: SLs can provide families with resources that help "level the playing field" for military children in K-12, while moving from school to school.
- Home School Linkage: SLs can share information on home schooling resources, policies, and legislation.
- **Resource & Referral:** SLs can provide information and refer families to other programs.
- Post Secondary Preparation: SLs can provide graduating students with access to post-secondary information and opportunities.
- Special Education: SLs work in collaboration with EFMP and can answer questions on educational matters of children with special needs.
