All services are free of charge and designed to assist in the everyday demands of parenting in the military.

Home Visits

Individualized parent support and education for expectant parents or families with children 0-5. Services include:

- Discipline and managing difficult behaviors
- Connection to military and civilian resources
- Managing and navigating the unique needs of military families, such as issues of deployment and a mobile lifestyle

Infant massage is a wonderful and nurturing way to connect, communicate, and bond with your infant. The New Parent Support Program offers free individual classes, as well as a 4-week group class for caregivers with infants 4 weeks to 12 months of age.
