BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

Base Access: MCRD San Diego is located just northwest of downtown San Diego and north of the San Diego International Airport, Lindbergh Field. Gate 5 (Washington St.) is the main gate.

Rideshares: Rideshares (taxis, Uber, Lyft, etc.) are allowed access to the installation following a cursory vehicle search. If the rideshare driver chooses not to undergo the cursory vehicle search, the passenger must be dropped off at the designated pick -up/drop off location at each gate. A cursory vehicle search is an external visual inspection of the vehicle by law enforcement.

Gate 5 Coordinates: 32.739091, -117.185831 (Navigation apps will direct you to the wrong gate) or search "MCRD Gate 5" or "MCRD Visitor Center."

Entering and Leaving the Depot: All visitor vehicles MUST enter through Gate 5 (Washington St.). Vehicles and personnel will be searched upon entry. Expect delays and plan accordingly. Gate 5 opens at 4:00 PM for Meet & Greet and 6:30 AM for graduation visitors on Family Day and Graduation. Gate 4 (Old Town Ave.) and Gate 5 will be open for all visitors when departing MCRD San Diego.

Driver's License/Registration/Insurance:

If you are driving a vehicle, ensure you have a valid driver's license, vehicle registration, and proof of insurance in your possession.

Identification: Every person age sixteen and older is required to have a valid form of photo identification to gain base access. Acceptable forms of U.S. government issued identification include: driver's license, state identification card, passport, military dependent identification card, or school/work identification card (for persons under age 18).

Firearms/Weapons: All firearms and weapons are prohibited aboard MCRD San Diego. Prohibited weapons include but are not limited to: knives greater than 3 inches, switchblades greater than 2 inches, and brass knuckles.

Drugs: All controlled substances are prohibited aboard MCRD San Diego. Any person(s) found possessing a controlled substance or associated paraphernalia (i.e., smoking devices) will be found in violation of Federal law. A medical marijuana card does not authorize possession of marijuana aboard MCRD San Diego. Contraband will be seized and offenders may be cited and denied entry. Controlled substances include but are not limited to: marijuana (or related products), methamphetamines, hallucinogens, and prescription medication without a valid prescription.

Picnic Areas/Tailgate Lot/RV and Trailers: There are lawn spaces throughout the installation for visitors to picnic. It is requested that visitors who arrive with an RV or trailer, or whom wish to set-up pop-up tents and canopies to utilize the "Tailgate Lot" located adjacent to Bldg 10. Overnight parking, charcoal grills, and consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited on the premises.

Medical Treatment Facility: The Medical Treatment Facility aboard MCRD San Diego only provides services to recruits. They are unable to provide services to civilians or refill prescription medications. Please plan accordingly.

Boot Leave: Most recruits will book their travel for their boot leave on T-33 (week 6). They are provided an opportunity to make a phone call to confirm travel arrangements in advance of booking their airline tickets and transfers. Travel arrangements are booked through MCCS Camp Pendleton Latitudes Travel.



Lost and Found

Family Day Info Binder

The information below outlines common questions asked/information given throughout Family Day. Always check with the graduation schedule and sequence of events provided on the day of family day (or on the MCCS website) for the most up to date information on schedules and hours of operations.

Family Day FAQ

Where can I smoke?

Parking lots must be 50 ft away from any building.

Where can we get a wheelchair or scooter?

Guest Services (Bldg. 16). Direct families on map or provide directions, if needed.

Is there a place on base to breastfeed?

Mothers are welcome to breastfeed wherever they'd like. In the future, we plan to have a dedicated area in the welcome center.

Who to call for a dead car battery while on base?

Families will have to coordinate this service. We would recommend providing them with PMO's number 619-524-4202 so they can inform them that a service will need to access the installation to jump start a vehicle. A good Samaritan may have jumper cables though!

Where is the other place to rent for hotels?

To avoid federal endorsement, we can't recommend specific hotels. However, the surrounding areas include Liberty Station, Point Loma, Old Town, and Downtown San Diego.

Is there a place on base to store any personal belongings for the visiting family and new marines?

Families can store personal belongings in their vehicle or lodging location. It is recommended that they keep all of their belongs. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Where is the shuttle located after graduation day? To be drop off to the airport?

MCRDSD does not have a shuttle for transporting people to the airport. Some of the local hotels do have shuttles.



Some Marines have purchased Sea Breeze vouchers through ITT Latitudes for transportation from MCRD to the San Diego Airport. The pick-up location is in front of the Theater. Families can utilize Sea Breeze shuttle. I believe the cost is \$15 (cash only).

What are the operation hours of the shuttle to the airport?

MCRDSD does not have a shuttle for transporting people to the airport. Some of the local hotels have shuttles. We recommend checking with that hotel for the specific information on their shuttle.

Where is the place to buy plane tickets?

New Marines that purchased plane tickets through CPEN ITT Latitudes can contact them at: 760-763-3183/3184. However, they may be busy on Thursdays as that's when we have a AM and PM brief to book travel for Week 6 recruits. The Library has a computer lab if families wanted to research and purchase plane tickets there.

Where is the first aid kit area?

For any emergency situations, please call 911. Many MCCS facilities have a first aid kit.

How to find or locate my new marine?

On family day, the Senior Drill Instructor will inform you where to sit for your Marine's platoon and that will make it easier. If you do not know your Marine's platoon number, stop by the information tent and they can give you that information. On graduation, there are signs behind the bleachers with the platoon numbers. Make sure to sit in that area and it will be easier to find your Marine.

Where to charge my cellphone?

There is Wi-Fi and a charging station at the library.
